	Election results are still being counted, very close results, approximately 1,700 votes whether it passes or not.
	 Homeless/Housing Initiatives Releasing a request for letters of interest from any organization with expertise in homelessness and special populations that are over-represented and underserved in homelessness (e.g. LGBTQ, fleeing domestic violence) that will provide interim housing (BHBH) with stabilization and barrier busting services while the behavioral health provider supports the client to find permanent housing. Releasing mid-March. Partnering with SUPT to support their knowledge and involvement in the homeless sector. In the last 12 months, HEART provided nearly 1,900 outreach encounters and 705 people agreed to work with HEART. 625 people were enrolled in a BHS outpatient program and of those enrollments, 350 showed up to their first appointment. It is our plan to break out SUD and MH linkage in future data dashboards. HEART in process of developing videos to post to our webpage to help the community learn more about the team.
