The Mental Health Board is mandated by state law and advises the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors and Mental Health Director as it reviews and provides oversight of mental health services.

- Conducts Site Visits
- Recommends Budgets for Mental Health Services
- Reviews County Performance Outcome Data
- Reviews and Evaluates Mental Health Needs, Facilities and Services

Who are the Mental Health Board?

The Mental Health Board members are your diverse neighbors, community leaders, consumers of services, family members of those with mental illness, peers, professionals and volunteers who have an interest to support and advocate for mental health services.

There are 16 appointed members, 3 from each district plus a member of the Board of Supervisors.
