

# The Adult Outpatient Services Transformation

## What Changed?

#### Former Outpatient System

#### **Low Intensity**

#### **Wellness & Recovery Center**

- 2 walk-in locations
- Capacity: 1000 annually for the wellness centers
- Capacity: 500 per site for outpatient program

#### **Guest House**

- 1 walk-in location
  - Capacity: 500

#### Low to Moderate Intensity

#### **Regional Support Teams**

- 4 organizations, 5 locations
  - Capacity: 1,050 per organization

#### **Moderate to High Intensity**

#### **TCORE**

- 1 location
- Capacity: 700
- Flexible site-based and community-based services

#### Transformed System

#### Flexible, Low to High Intensity

### CORE Community Wellness Center

- 11 peer run walk-in locations
- Capacity: 600 per site annually
- 11 outreach teams for linking the unsheltered to the Mental Health Plan



#### **CORE Outpatient Program**

- 11 locations
- Capacity: 700 per site at any given time
- Flexible site-based and community-based services, including housing supports

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\*Capacity is defined as the number of clients served within a 30 day period.

### **CORE** Outpatient Program - Specialty Mental Health

#### **Standard Specialty Mental Health Services**

- Assessment
- Intensive Case Management (ICM)
- Collateral services
- Crisis Intervention
- Medication Support Services
- Plan Development
- Rehabilitation
- Therapy



#### **Enhanced CORE Services**

- Trauma informed care
- Culturally and linguistically responsive and recovery-oriented care.
- The "Strengths Model," a recovery-oriented practice model
- Provide focused, time-limited, individual and/or group mental health services using best practices, community defined practices, evidence based practices, curriculum based practices and/or promising practices to all clients.
- The "SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access, and Recovery (SOAR)" program model increases access to Social Security disability benefits for people experiencing or at risk of homelessness
- Peer Support Services, a system of giving and receiving help based on key principles that include shared responsibility, and mutual agreement of what is helpful
- Flexible, community/field-based specialty mental health service level of intensity and phase of treatment that matches the needs of the client.
- Housing Support Services


## **CORE Staffing**

- In addition to standard Medi-Cal requirements for staffing, CORE Program staffing is:
  - Reflective of the cultural, racial, ethnic, linguistic, sexual, and gender diversity of Sacramento County
  - An array that includes a combination of education and experience, ranging from persons with lived experience, to licensed team members
  - Specialized, relevant to program implementation and practices, such as those specialized in housing supports, benefit acquisition, and employment resources

Robust performance data, client progress, and feedback





CORE provides specialty mental health outpatient services at 11 sites throughout Sacramento County. In addition to these sites, services are delivered in the community, wherever requested. Each CORE site has a co-located peer run community wellness center, which is open to any Sacramento County adult seeking meaningful activities. Services are strength-based, recovery focused, and flexible. As your needs change, your level of treatment intensity can be adjusted.
