AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP)	<p>Medications used in the treatment and suppression of HIV/AIDS.</p> <p>Apply in person at an authorized ADAP enrollment site. Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program (BCCTP)	<p>Cancer treatment for eligible individuals diagnosed with breast and/or cervical cancer.</p> <p>Apply in person at an EWC or Family PACT provider's office (see below) https://www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/medi-cal/Pages/BCCTP.aspx</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Screened and found in need of treatment for breast and/or cervical cancer by an EWC or Family PACT provider. • Monthly gross family income at or below 200% FPL.
Every Woman Counts (EWC)	<p>Cancer screening and treatment services for breast and cervical cancer.</p> <p>Apply by phone 1-800-511-2300 http://dhcs.ca.gov/EveryWomanCounts</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 40 years or older for breast cancer screening (any age if symptomatic); 21 years or older for cervical cancer screening. • Income at or below 200% FPL. • No insurance or limited insurance. • Ineligible for Medi-Cal, Covered CA, or other public programs.
Family Planning, Access, Care and Treatment (PACT)	<p>Comprehensive family planning services including contraception, pregnancy testing with counseling, preconception counseling, male and female sterilization, limited infertility services, cancer screening, HIV screening, & sexually transmitted infection testing and treatment.</p> <p>Apply in person at any Family PACT provider's office www.familypact.org</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Family income at or below 200% FPL. • No other source of family planning coverage. • No Medi-Cal and no access to health insurance. • Medi-Cal clients with an unmet share of cost may also be eligible.
Genetically Handicapped Persons Program (GHPP)	<p>Medical care for persons with specific conditions, such as hemophilia and sickle cell disease.</p> <p>Apply by mail http://www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/ghpp</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 21 years or older. (Those under 21 must apply first to CCS.) • No income limit, but may require a yearly enrollment fee. • May have other insurance, but limitations will apply. • Diagnosed with a genetic condition that is covered by GHPP.
Improving Access Counseling & Treatment For Californians With Prostate Cancer (IMPACT)	<p>Prostate cancer treatment services for men.</p> <p>Apply by phone 1-800-409-8252 http://www.california-impact.org/</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 18 years of age or older. • Income at or below 200% FPL. • Has little or no health insurance. • Abnormal DRE or elevated PSA. • Diagnosed with prostate cancer.

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Medi-Cal Access Program (MCAP)	<p>Low cost health coverage for middle-income pregnant women. MCAP subscriber pays a total cost of 1.5% of modified adjusted gross income.</p> <p>Information: http://mcap.dhcs.ca.gov/Home/default.aspx Apply online at: www.CoveredCA.com</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pregnant as of the application date. • Has no health insurance OR health plan has a maternity-only deductible or copayment greater than \$500. • Cannot have no-cost Medi-Cal or Medicare Part A and Part B. • Household income between 213% - 322% FPL.
Restricted Medi-Cal Benefits	<p>Restricted benefits cover emergency, pregnancy-related, and long term care services only.</p> <p>Apply at a county eligibility office or online: www.dha.saccounty.net</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults age 19-64 with income at or below 138% FPL, <i>or</i> • Pregnant and has income at or below 213% FPL, <i>or</i> • 65 years of age or older with income at or below 100% FPL plus a standard disregard based on family size.
Healthy Partners*	<p>Primary care services for low-income adult residents of Sacramento County who cannot get other health care coverage.</p> <p><i>Enrollment limited to 4,000 members.</i> Member Services: 916-874-1805</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 19 years of age or older. • Sacramento County resident. • Income at or below 138% FPL. • Has restricted Medi-Cal; ineligible for other health insurance.

California Children's Services (CCS)	<p>Medical care for children with specific health conditions, such as congenital heart disease and uncontrollable seizures.</p> <p>Apply at: http://www.dhs.saccounty.net/PUB/Pages/California-Childrens-Services/SP-California-Childrens-Services.aspx or http://www.dhcs.ca.gov/services/ccs</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under 21 years old. • Has Medi-Cal, or the family's adjusted gross income is less than \$40,000, or out-of-pocket medical expenses are expected to be more than 20% of the adjusted gross income. • Has a physical disability or medical condition that is covered by CCS. • Resides in Sacramento County with parent/guardian.
Child Health And Disability Prevention (CHDP)	<p>Free health exams for low to moderate income children and youth.</p> <p>Apply in person with an enrolled CHDP provider. http://www.dhs.saccounty.net/PUB/CHDP/Pages/CHDP-Home.aspx</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enrolled in Medi-Cal and under 21 years old, <i>or</i> • Ineligible for Medi-Cal, under 19 years old, and has a family income at or below 266% FPL.
Kaiser Community Health Care Program*	<p>Provides a subsidy to help pay monthly premiums and most out-of-pocket medical costs. Members do not pay a monthly premium, and there are low or no costs for most services provided at Kaiser Permanente facilities.</p> <p><i>Must apply during Open Enrollment.</i> For more information: https://charitablehealth.kaiserpermanente.org/northern-california/</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under 19 years old (under 26 in Fresno, Kings, & Madera). • Lives in a household with income up to 300% FPL. • No access to any other health care coverage. • Lives in a Kaiser Permanente service area.
