

The total records entered into our database for January through December 2006 meeting these criteria were 82,045. We estimate that an additional 5.23% of the patient care records meeting these criteria did not get included in the database. Our estimated total number of patients at 911 medical aid scene calls for January through December 2006 is 86,573.






