Weekly COVID-19 Data as of August 31, 2022

- Total number of COVID-19 tests since March 2020: 47, 742 (*Net increase = 577*)
- Total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases since March 2020: 4,115 (*Net increase = 19*)
- Total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases during the intake observation/quarantine period since March 2020: 887 (*Net increase = 5*)
- Total number of COVID-19 positive inmates currently in custody: Main Jail – 14 / RCCC – 24
- Total number of COVID-19 related deaths: 3

Inmate Vaccination Data

As of 8/31/22, 3,176 inmates received at least one COVID-19 vaccine dose.

- Net increase of sixteen (16) new inmates receiving initial doses.
- Net increase of fourteen (14) booster doses.
- Total of forty doses (40) doses provided these past two weeks.

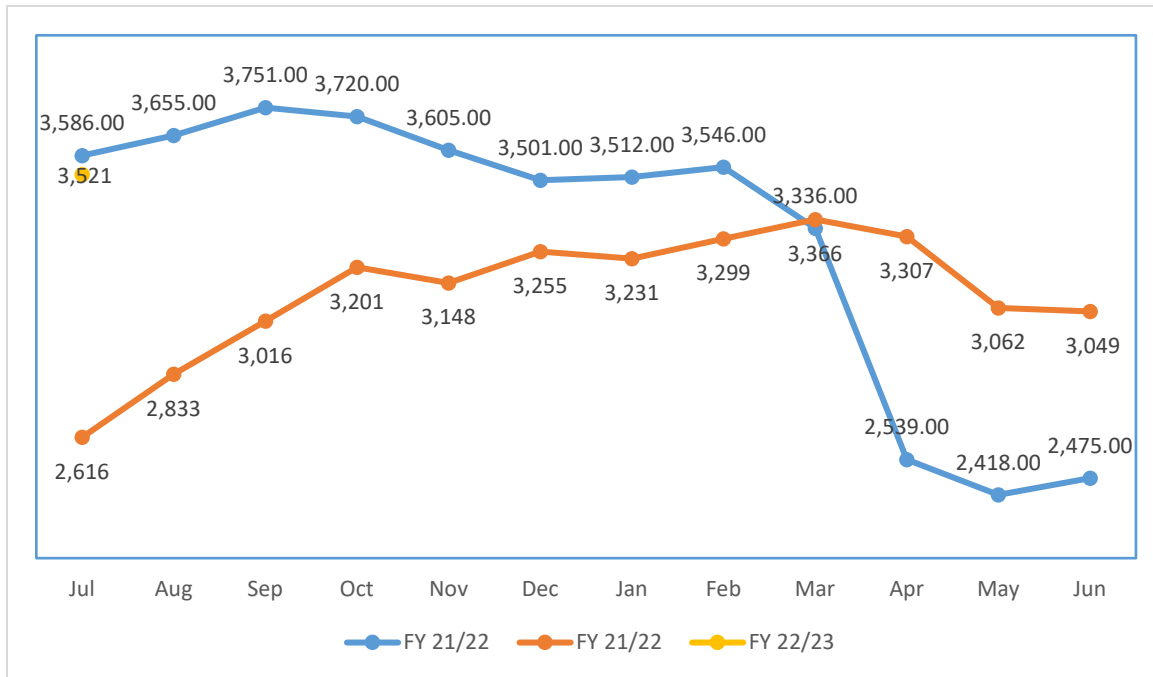
- Mental Health Staff - 96% are fully vaccinated & boosted.
- Registry– 87% fully vaccinated, 66% boosted.
- Other Contractors – 97% fully vaccinated, 59% boosted.

**Nurse Intake**

- In FY21-22, ACH completed an average of 2,377 intakes.
- Nurses completed 2,577 intakes in July for FY 2022/23, indicating an increase of 200.
- Approximately **32%** of the intakes for each month met the definition of homelessness. RN must mark “housed” or “homeless” at intake.

*Homeless Definition: living in a place not meant for human habitation (street, car, river, camp, etc.), shelter, transitional housing, or exiting other institution where they temporarily resided (less than 90 days).*

### Jail Facilities Average Daily Population (ADP)



The highest ADP was pre-pandemic in September 2019 (3,751) and the lowest ADP (2,418) was May 2020.
