Protocol:

BLS
1. ABC's/Routine Care-Supplemental O ₂ as necessary to maintain SPO ₂ ≥ 94%. Use lowest concentration and flow rate of O ₂ as possible. Airway adjuncts as needed. 2. Transport in position of comfort
ALS
1. Establish vascular access for any of the following, with Normal Saline and titrate to a systolic blood pressure of ≥ 90 mmHg. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hemodynamically unstable/Hypoperfusion • Concurrent respiratory compromise • Glasgow Coma Score ≤13 • Significant hemorrhage • Pulsatile abdominal mass • Suspected ectopic pregnancy • May establish an IV for pain management 2. Establish cardiac monitoring 3. Pain Control: For severe pain, consider administration of pain medications per PD# 8066 (Pain Management Policy) 4. Consider treating nausea and/or vomiting per PD #8063 (Nausea and/or Vomiting)
