**Purpose:**

- A. To establish a treatment standard for treating pediatric patients with nausea and/or vomiting.

**Authority:**

- A. California Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9

**Protocol:**

<b>BLS</b>	
1.	Consider oxygen therapy per Pediatric Airway Management PD # 8837
2.	Assess and treat, as appropriate, for underlying cause.
3.	Perform blood glucose
4.	Maintain normal body temperature
<b>ALS</b>	
1.	Cardiac Monitoring
2.	If vital signs or exam suggests volume depletion, consider: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) IV/IO access</li> <li>b) Normal Saline 20 ml/kg x 1</li> <li>c) Recheck vitals every 5 minutes</li> </ul>
3.	Consider Ondansetron <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Patients <math>\geq</math> 40 kg: 4 mg PO/IV/IO; Max 4 mg</li> <li>b) Patients <math>\leq</math> 40 kg: 0.1 mg/kg slow IV/IO push; Max 4 mg</li> </ul>
