## ALCOHOL AND DRUG ADVISORY BOARD MEETING GUIDELINES

- 1. Everyone is encouraged to participate Use of laptops and other devices should be limited to making presentations, keeping notes, or looking up relevant information.
- 2. Start and finish on time Don't punish the prompt by making them wait for stragglers or reward late-comers by repeating discussions or revisiting decisions.
- 3. One conversation at a time Show respect for others by listening to their point of view and refraining from side conversations.
- 4. Different opinions are welcome Contrary views need to be encouraged to support robust decision-making and to prevent group-think.
- 5. Challenge ideas, not individuals Emotions can run high and criticism can turn personal if attendees aren't reminded to focus on the issues.
- 6. Stay on point, make your point and move on to allow other meeting participants time to comment don't filibuster.
