Structured workgroups covering a variety of areas were discussed. <p>Lori Miller, ADS Program Manager:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> On August 20, 2019, the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors proclaimed September as Alcohol and Drug Recovery Month. On September 4, 2019, the annual Recovery Happens event at the state Capitol was held. ADS received great support from providers and staff. Jennifer Churchill requested that communication be improved from the County and the advisory board in regards to having advisory board members assist in staffing the table at the event. September 12, 2019 the first annual "Take the Mic for Recovery" event will be held at the Sierra 2 Center. There are 260 people reserved to attend currently. This will be the first year and will be an annual event moving forward. Contracted Residential providers are still awaiting Drug Medi-Cal certification for the new Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System waiver.
