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Advisory Board Committee Reports: Status of Goals & Action Steps	 Criminal Justice Committee Anti-recidivism Coalition will be presenting at the Monday, June 28, 2021 meeting. Prevention Committee Nicholas Erickson is the new Prevention Committee Co-Chair and a welcomed addition to the committee. The draft Strategic Prevention Plan (SPP) has been submitted to the State of California Department of Health Care Services for approval. The two priority areas of the SPP are underage cannabis/marijuana use and underage and binge drinking. Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Report Dr. Ryan Quist, Director, Behavioral Health Services	Dr. Ryan Quist provided the following report: Budget hearings for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 Recommended Budget are today, Wednesday, June 9, 2021 through Friday, June 11, 2021. Methamphetamine specific residential program is part of the recommended budget. BHS recommend the implementation of Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) (Laura's Law) to the Sacramento County BOS. The BOS approved the implementation of AOT. There will be more



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	community stakeholder meetings to start the AOT planning process for implementation.
	Wellness Crisis Call Center (formerly Alternatives to 911) was presented to the BOS today. BOS is looking at a very expedited timeline. More information and scheduled community meetings will be announced as planning begins. Dr. Quist is seeking support and representation from the Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board at the upcoming planning meetings. Advisory Board members shared their thoughts about the program and enthusiastically agreed to participate in the planning process.
	The FY 2021-22 Recommended Budget also includes a proposal for additional staff for the encampment /navigator teams. Proposal includes three new teams.
	On behalf of Lori Miller, Dr. Andrew Mendonsa, SUPT Health Program Manager, provided the following report:
	Dr. Mendonsa will be representing SUPT at the Public Health Advisory Board (PHAB) meetings going forward. The PHAB is pleased to have SUPT representation and looks forward to future collaboration.
Substance Use Prevention and Treatment Services (SUPT) Report Lori Miller, SUPT Division Manager	Dr. Mendonsa discussed a recent article included in <i>The Journal of the American Medical Association</i> regarding an increase use of methamphetamines by certain cultural/ethnic groups. Dr. Mendonsa will share the article with Board members.
	The SSP has been submitted to the state. Thanks to Stephanie Dasalla and Joyce Bartlett for their hard work and diligence on the project. The two priority areas included in the SSP are underage cannabis/marijuana use and underage and binge drinking.



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	SUPT is planning on transitioning back to in- person services in the near future. SUPT will continue to offer some virtual telehealth options. UC Davis Emergency Department Bridge program will be a contracted Medication Assisted Treatment service provider for Sacramento County Drug Medi-Cal clients.
