

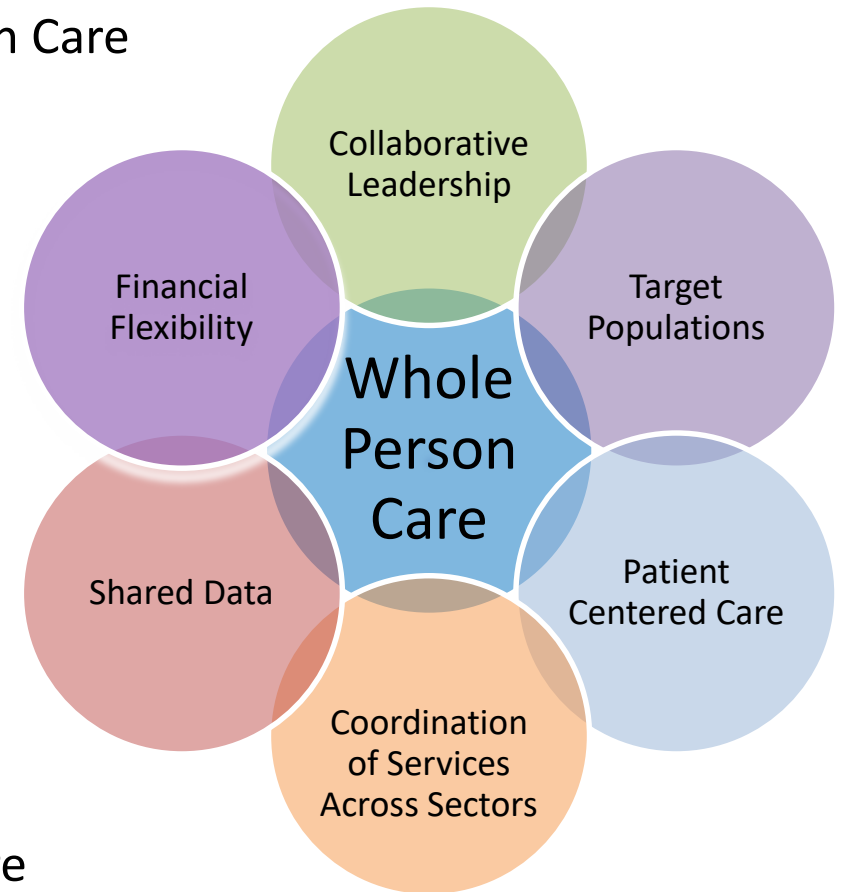

# What Exactly is Whole Person Care & Pathways?

- Pathways to Health + Home is the City of Sacramento's Whole Person Care (WPC) pilot program
- WPC is a pilot for high-risk Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are frequent users of multiple care systems and still have poor health outcomes
- Provides flexible funding to achieve the "Triple Aim": Better Care, Improved Health, Lower Costs
- Pilots identify target populations, assess health and housing needs, coordinate care in real-time, and evaluate outcomes
- Promotes collaboration, coordination, and data sharing infrastructure



# Overarching Pathways Goals

Align	Align with the City of Sacramento's commitment to moving 2,000 individuals experiencing homelessness from the streets to housing by 2020
Integrate	Integrate the systems of care serving high-risk, high-utilizing homeless populations through care coordination and data-sharing
Achieve	Achieve performance outcomes, including a reduction in avoidable hospitalizations and an increase in connection to housing services
Improve	Improve the health and quality of life for individuals experiencing homelessness

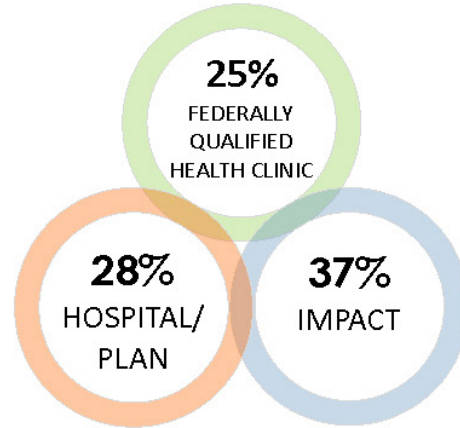

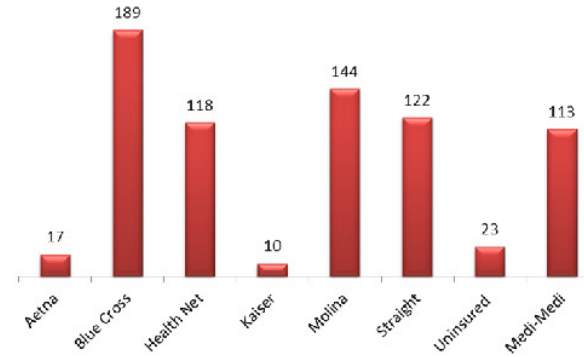

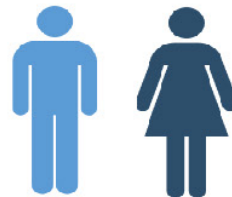

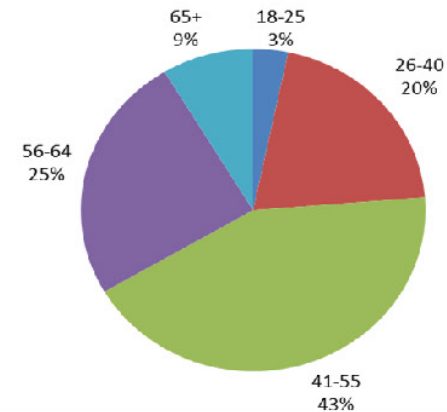

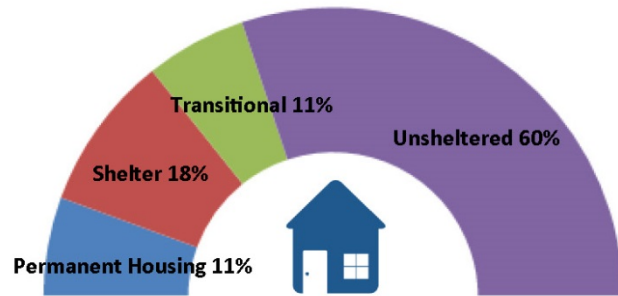

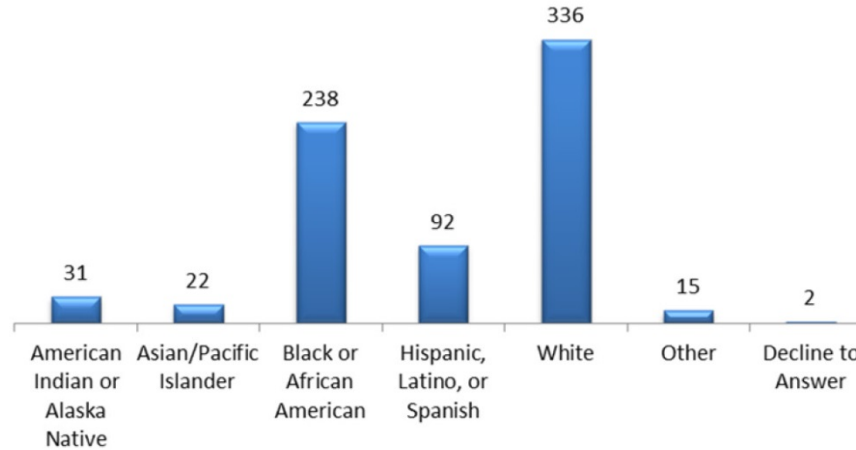
