## H1N1 Flu Video Update Available from Sacramento County Public Health

(Sacramento, CA) -- To help keep the public informed on H1N1 flu, Sacramento County Public Health today released a web video updating the public on H1N1 flu.

In the video, Sacramento County Public Heath Officer Dr. Glennah Trochet, M.D., covers the basics on the H1N1 flu and how the public can help minimize the spread of the virus. It is important for parents to have a plan in case a child becomes sick, or school closures occur at some point in the future.

The video discusses the recent release by the Centers for Disease Control of guidance for schools, as well as the timeline for expected availability of seasonal and H1N1 vaccines.

Although it is unknown exactly what will happen this flu season, it is important for the public to be prepared in case the H1N1 flu later turns out to be more virulent than the generally mild cases being reported now.
