Free H1N1 Vaccinations Available for Everyone at "Kids Day in the Park" and "Festival De La Familia" This Weekend April 24-25

(Sacramento, CA) – H1N1 flu is still with us, and Sacramento County Public Health continues to offer free H1N1 flu vaccination opportunities.

Public Health staff will be on hand this Saturday, April 24th, at "Kids Day in the Park" at Hagan Park in Rancho Cordova and on Sunday, April 25th, at "Festival De La Familia" at Cal Expo to administer vaccines and answer questions about H1N1 flu. The free vaccinations will be made available to everyone who attends the popular annual festival regardless of the County they live in.

"H1N1 flu is a serious disease that continues to circulate and is expected to be with us for the foreseeable future. I want to urge everyone to be immunized so they are fully protected against H1N1 flu," said Glennah Trochet, M.D., Sacramento County Health Officer. "H1N1 has caused over 500 hospitalizations and 23 deaths in Sacramento County since it broke out a year ago. It's not too late to get vaccinated," Trochet said.

"Kids Day in the Park" will take place on Saturday, April 24th, from 11:00 AM- 3:00 PM at Hagan Park, 2197 Chase Drive, Rancho Cordova. "Festival De La Familia" will be held on Sunday, April 25th, from 10:00 Am – 6:00 PM on the grounds of Cal Expo, 1600 Exposition Blvd., Sacramento

In addition to the weekend events, Public Health is operating ongoing weekly H1N1 flu clinics at nine additional locations. See the complete schedule on the following page for specific dates and times.
