Free whooping cough clinics scheduled for August

Tdap booster shots available to anyone 10 or older; clinics support law requiring junior high, high school students to be immunized against whooping cough

SACRAMENTO, CA – The Sacramento County Department of Health and Human Services Immunization Assistance Program is offering free whooping cough vaccination clinics in August. State law requires that all 7th-12th graders be immunized against the disease within 30 days of starting the school year.

Individuals age 10 and older can receive a whooping cough booster shot (also known as a Tdap) at the following clinics.
