Welcome, introductions and announcements – Nancy Gilberti	Nancy Gilberti welcomed all to the meeting and reviewed the packet of materials for today's discussion. She informed the Co-Applicant Board (CAB) that applications for those members awaiting formal approval will be considered by the Board of Supervisors on September 13, 2016.
	Nancy is also planning agendas for the remainder of the year and asked the CAB to submit agenda items to her.
Member Recruitment Strategies – Sally Ooms and Nancy Gilberti	A subcommittee of Paula Lomazzi, Sally Ooms, and Nancy Gilberti met earlier this month and they drafted a recruitment flyer and tri-fold brochure which provides information about the CAB and its purpose. The plan is to post flyers and give brochures to those who express interest. The subcommittee also drafted a modified CAB application which Nancy submitted to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for consideration. A photo of the CAB in action will be added to the brochure. Materials will also be translated into Spanish.
	The CAB conceptually approved the materials and plan of action.
Quality Improvement Plan – Marcia Jo	Marcia Jo facilitated discussion about the quality improvement goals and objectives from the FY 2016/17 Health Center Quality Improvement Plan. Objectives discussed were: (1) strong clinical outcomes; (2) engaging and effective patient experience; (3) create ideal environment for providers, clinical learners, and facility; and (4) budget targets met. The CAB recommended that mental health be added to the clinical outcomes section.
	Discussion ensued regarding the homeless. The CAB wants to review: • Needs assessment tool
