- **In Person** at the County Department of Human Assistance (DHA) offices. See DHA website for locations.
- **By Mail** with a <u>Single Streamlined Application</u>, provided in English and other languages. Send completed and signed applications to your <u>local county social</u> services office.

 - o You can apply for Medi-Cal through Covered California year round.
 - Covered California is also where you can get health insurance under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and see if you qualify for financial subsidies. Open enrollment for health plans through Covered California is November 1st through January 31st. Individuals who experience a qualifying life event may be eligible to enroll in private coverage through Covered California by applying for special enrollment.
