Definitions:

Top 3% – The top 3% of utilization is measured by the total sum of both inpatient and emergency department (ED) claims.

Homelessness – Defined by diagnosis code ICD 10 Z590 and “Homeless” is listed as the member address.

*Exception:* Kaiser defined homelessness as “Address field contains any of the following: Homeless, no address, none, address not found, 00000, box 1532, unknown, general delivery, transient, or none per member.”
