



COVID-19 QUARANTINE GUIDANCE UPDATE February 15, 2021

General Quarantine Guidance

Close contacts to suspected or confirmed COVID-19 cases may discontinue quarantine after Day 10 without testing if asymptomatic, with some exceptions (see <u>Health Advisory: updated COVID-19 quarantine guidelines from December 15, 2020).</u>

Quarantine Guidance for Fully Vaccinated Individuals

Fully vaccinated individuals with an exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 are **NOT** required to quarantine if they meet **ALL** of the following criteria:

- Are fully vaccinated (i.e., ≥2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or
 ≥2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine)
- Are within 3 months following receipt of the last dose in the series
- Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure
