



COVID-19 Vaccine Reporting August 4, 2021

Per the June 26, 2021 State Health Officer Order, all acute health care and long-term care settings, high-risk congregate settings, and other health care settings identified in the Order must verify vaccine status of all workers and have a plan in place for tracking verified worker vaccination status. As of August 16, 2021, Sacramento County Public Health (SCPH) will be requiring the following facilities to report the vaccination status of all workers, including contracted staff, to SCPH:

- General Acute Care Hospitals
- Skilled Nursing Facilities (including subacute facilities)
- Intermediate Care Facilities
- Congregate Living Health Facilities

The survey will ask for facility information (name, type, address), submitter information (name, position/title, contact information), and vaccination status as follows:
