Approval of the October 6, 2020 meeting minutes was moved by Debra Payne and seconded by Terry Jones. No nay votes or abstentions, the October 1 meeting minutes were approved.

3. 2:10 DHCS

Alani Jackson (absent)

a. <u>Dental Transformation Initiative Update</u>

Carolyn Brookins reported: <u>Domain 1 (Provider Reimbursement)</u>: No update since the October meeting. <u>Domain 2 (CAMBRA)</u>: As of Sept 1, \$119.3 M has been paid. \$6.74 M paid to Sacramento County. Of that, \$4.8M is DMC and \$1.9M is FFS.

Domain 2 has 3,881 providers who have opted in for FFS, DMC and safety net clinics; this reflects a 1.6% growth in providers since Sept 2020.

<u>Domain 3 (Continuity of Care)</u>: This domain is not operative in Sacramento County and there is no update since the last meeting. The next payment will go out in June 2021. There are 120 safety net clinics participating.

Domain 4 (Local Dental Pilot Projects): \$82.2 M has been issued to date. Sacramento County has received \$6.6 M. The final teleconference with LDPP's will be Dec 17 where closeout guidelines will be discussed. DHCS has not received word regarding the 2020 Waiver extension request. If necessary, a 30 day extension letter will be submitted to CMS. Providers will only see a change if CMS denies the extension request which is not expected.

b. Prop 56 update

Carolyn Brookins reported:

FY 19-20 FFS providers statewide received \$360 M for FFS - statewide, and \$14.9 M for DMC in Sacramento County.

FY 20-21 FFS providers statewide received \$67.5 M for FFS, and \$950,000 for DMC in Sacramento County.

In Governor's may budget revision, there was a statement that Prop 56 funding has the potential of being suspended if there are not sufficient funds. This is tentatively scheduled for June 30, 2021 – if it happens.

Dharia stated negotiations will happen from January through June and a decision will be known by June 30, 2021. CDA and other advocates will be pushing for an extension beyond June, 2021.

4. 2:40 Subcommittee to Study DMC Performance Data (Action) Danielle Cannarozzi

Danielle proposed the idea of forming a subcommittee to determine, in addition to the 13 metrics DHCS is required to report on, what other data points dental plans could share to help MCDAC, DHCS and stakeholders better understand Sacramento's dental landscape. The goal of providing additional data is to provide as much transparency as possible to make decisions and to deliver a full picture of dental plan efforts.

Group discussed best way to determine additional metrics, whether that be by forming a MCDAC subcommittee or by having the dental plans meet to develop a plan, acceptable to DHCS, to present to MCDAC prior to the formation of a subcommittee.

A substitute motion was proposed by Cathy Levering for the dental plans to develop a plan for review of additional data points for review and to bring the plan back to

MCDAC for discussion. Jonathan Porteus seconded. Roll call vote: Yes – All No – None Abstain – None Motion – Approved See attached roll call vote spreadsheet.

- 5. 2:50 Disclosure Category Changes (Action) Terry Jones
 - a. Andrew, Levering, Porteus, Valencia

Jan stated boards and commissions undergo a review of member disclosure status every two years. During the last review, four MCDAC members needed to have a disclosure change because their organization received funding through the DTI grant. MCDAC votes on the changes and if approved will make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors who will ratify the recommendation.

Katie Andrew made a motion for MCDAC to make a recommendation to change the disclosure status for the four members to add the BC03 status to the existing BC01 disclosure.

CORRECTION 12/16/20: Upon review, the existing disclosure status for all MCDAC members is BC02. This recommendation adds the BC03 status for the four members described above.

Robin Blanks-Guster seconded the motion.

6. 3:00 Special Needs/General Anesthesia Work Group Update Debra Payne

Debra and the chairs of the committees provided updates on the special needs/general anesthesia work groups.

<u>Group 1 (Payne)</u> – Communications group came up with a cover letter and a list of 35 recipients including legislators and funders to send the Barbara Aved study. <u>Group 2 and Group 4 (Glassman)</u> merged into one group – Education. Sonya Bingaman reported. There are ongoing efforts with regional centers and CNU to implement desensitization and treatment activities to minimize the number of patients that require general anesthesia for dental care.

<u>Group 3 (Payne)</u> – Dental surgery center. There was an original proposal for a surgery center made by Dr. Weideman and Tse. This has morphed into include CNU and funding is being sought. CNU has agreed to include a dental surgery center in its hospital building plans, which greatly helps fund-raising efforts for the dental side. <u>Group 5 (Andrew)</u> – Promote DHCS medical/dental collaboration. Katie is drafting a letter with recommendations for DHCS which the subcommittee will discuss and review. Group 5 will bring these recommendations back to MCDAC prior to submitting to DHCS. After the October meeting, Julie Gallelo and Mary Jess Wilson withdrew their names from consideration for the position of Vice Chair. After consultation with County Counsel, MCDAC members were sent an email suggesting that the vote for Chair between Katie Andrew and Debra Payne move forward and that whoever received the greatest number of votes would become Chair and the person receiving the remaining votes would become Vice Chair. No members responded in opposition to that suggestion. During this meeting, two members expressed opposition and it was determined to vote for the Chair position and hold a subsequent nomination and vote for the Vice Chair position. Darrel Kenworthy made a motion to do a roll call vote for the Chair position. Terry Jones seconded the motion.

A roll call vote was taken on the motion. All members present voted yes except Jim Musser who voted no.

A roll call vote for the chair position was taken.

Jim Musser - abstained. See attached roll call vote spreadsheet.

Debra Payne was elected as the Chair of MCDAC.

Katie Andrew, Cathy Levering and Steve Heath were nominated to run for Vice Chair, declined.

<u>Health Net</u> – Dorothy reported Health Net has added four addition team members and is in the process of launching teledental services.

Dharia reported the legislature reconvenes next week. CDA is advocating for dental professionals to be included in the first phase of the vaccine distribution plan.

10. 3:40 Children Now Update

Katie reported Children Now has a sign-on letter to preserve the allocation of Prop 56 funds as they currently are. The link to that letter was shared in the chat. The deadline to sign is December 8. Children Now sponsored a care coordination brief examining the efforts of the local dental pilot projects and shared this with MCDAC. Katie will be presenting the brief on December 18 at the CNU virtual symposium.

Debra reported the last ESC meeting was today. DTI funding ends 12/31/2020. Robyn Alongi reported the medical dental integration pilot has three RDHAP's and two RDHs operating in pediatric clinics. The Medical Dental Referral and Navigation database is operational and contains beneficiary information for Medi-Cal children ages 0-20 and females of childbearing age for managed care and fee for service. The system can be used to make and track referrals and care coordination efforts through claims data. Any medical facility can join the system and use it to refer people to their dental provider and to track care coordination efforts.
