Presentation	 Kimbra Andrews – California Product Stewardship Council (CPSC) – "Don't Rush to Flush" Overview and history of the program Formed by eight counties and eventually became a non-profit. Watershed protection grant – Rose Foundation Project Initial goal is to place six medication collection sites in Sacramento and Yolo Counties. Ultimate goal is to have manufacturers of medications such as pharmaceutical companies pay for disposal of unused medications. Currently waiting to find out if the Sacramento County Sheriffs Department will host a site. Only law enforcement can collect certain controlled substances. Unused medications pose a threat to public health through seepage into the water supply. Studies show that 30 – 50% of medications prescribed are not taken. CPSC will forward information from studies completed that are relevant to Sacramento County as they are completed. PR Event scheduled for July 10. Web: www.CalPSC.org
