	LOW INCOME HEALTH PROGRAM (LIHP)
	Enrollment as of 02/01/13 is 7,222 enrollees. We are projecting approximately 650–750 more by the end of the month. We will be adding some additional Primary Care medical groups in certain geographic locations to expand our network. This program will be transitioning into Medi-Cal Managed Care in 2014 under ACA. The Governors Budget provided two options for this program – either under the State Medi-Cal program or under Counties as an expansion of the LIHPs. The discussion of these options is occurring between the State and Counties as well as within an advisory stakeholders committee. The decision is expected during the budget process.

So far we have had 28 admissions to Intensive Care Units and 10 deaths, with 2 less than 65 years old. In addition, we have had 10 outbreaks reported in LTCFs. We still have vaccine available and are sending it to providers. We are not planning to have community clinics</li> <li>Norovirus update – We also have norovirus circulating in the community. We have had 10 outbreaks reported in LTCFs and it has impacted school attendance as well.</li> </ol>
