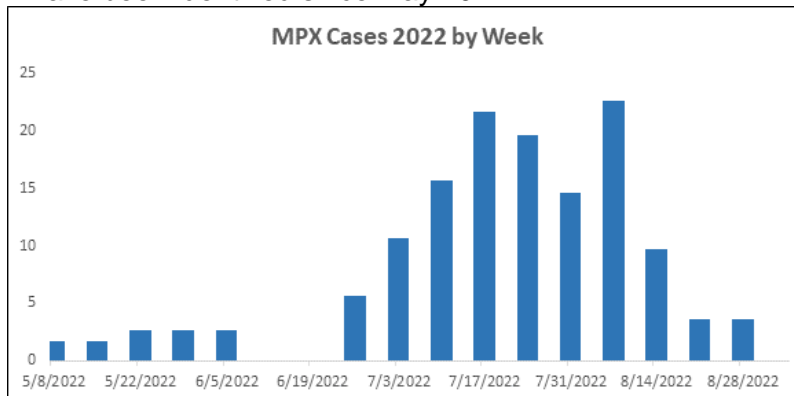

has participating agencies in all 50 states
not meant for general public or media

Sacramento County is now getting data in the ODMAP
Folsom Fire, Folsom Police, Sacramento County EMS (Ambulance Companies) (California EMS Authority)
Citrus Heights PD has an account but does not upload data currently
More meetings are being scheduled for further discussions with other Sacramento County law enforcement or fire agencies to assist them coming on board and adding manual data to the ODMAP system
