## Purpose:

A. To establish the standard when responding to a mutual aid request outside of Sacramento County.

## **Authority:**

- A. California Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9

## Policy:

- A. A Paramedic / Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) will render care according to the Sacramento County Emergency Medical Services Agency (SCEMSA) policies, procedures, and protocols when operating outside of Sacramento County on a mutual aid request.
- B. The Paramedic may use all the steps in the treatment protocols, respective to their scope of practice, not identified by "Base Hospital Order Only".-
- C. The Paramedic / EMT may transfer care to the most appropriate responder.
- Under the authority of State regulations, a Paramedic may render ALS care as per
   PD #222 Paramedic Scope of Practice.
- E. Under the authority of State regulations, an EMT may render Basic Life Support (BLS) care as per
  - PD# 2220 EMT Scope of Practice.

## **Documentation:**

- A. A patient care report (PCR) will be completed as per PD# 2305 EMS Patient Care Report-Competion and Distribution.
- B. Upon return to Sacramento County, a copy of the PCR will be delivered to the relevant employer no later than seventy-two (72) hours.
- C. If the PCR is unable to be delivered with the patient, the following will occur;
  - 1. Emergency medical services personnel accepting care of the patient will be provided:
    - Agency name
    - unit number
    - Crew names
    - State license or certification number.
  - 2. Document the name of the personnel accepting care of the patient and the patient destination if known.

3. The PCR will be completed, and a copy will be sent to the receiving entity no later than seventy-two (72) hours following return to Sacramento County.
