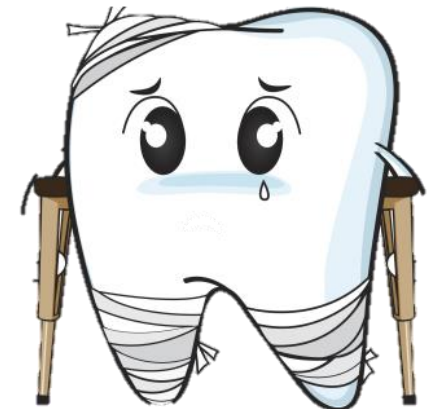

If you don't have Medi-Cal

**You should get help right away if you have:**

- Pain in the teeth, gums, face, or jaw
- Swollen gums or swollen face
- Infection on gums, or a bubble that appears on the gums
- Injury or trauma to the mouth or teeth
- A fever with any of the above symptoms



# Sacramento County

## Call your Dentist Office

- If it's after hours, follow the instructions given by the recording.
- If you cannot get a hold of your dentist office, call your dental plan and tell them you have a dental emergency.

## If you don't have a Dentist Office

- Call **Sacramento Covered: 916-414-8333**.
- They can help you find a dentist for the emergency and a dental office for ongoing care.

If it's after hours, call a dental clinic for emergency care. Then follow-up on the next business day by contacting Sacramento Covered to get a dentist for ongoing care.
